Submission requirements

- One unpublished empirical paper on themes related to **Asia Pacific trade and economic development** of 7000–10,000 words, including an abstract of less than 300 words
- A current résumé, including citizenship(s), date of birth and gender
- The applicant must be:
 - The individual author of the paper
 - Aged 35 years or younger on 3 June 2025
 - Available to participate for the duration of the Conference (3–5 June 2025)
- The applicant must not have been previously selected as a PAFTAD Young Fellow

- Publication of your paper as a PAFTAD Working Paper

Involvement in the 42nd PAFTAD Conference

- Present your paper at the Young Fellows Seminar and act as a discussant on another Young Fellow's paper (3 June 2025)
- Attend and provide comment where possible on the papers presented during the PAFTAD Conference (4-5 June 2025)
